The Brookshire Scholarship Award is given by the Brookshire family in honor of Bill and Myrtle Brookshire. Mrs. Brookshire was a Home Economics teacher at Johnson County High School for many years. Mrs. Brookshire's love for her students and her passion for the subject that she knew would increase the quality of their lives never wavered. Mr. Brookshire, one of the founders of Johnson County Bank in 1975, served as bank president and also on the JCB Board of Directors. He enjoyed supporting various community projects such as the 4-H Poultry Project, Little League Baseball, Heritage Hall, the Johnson County Center for the Arts and the Johnson County Senior Heating Assistance program. The impact of these two good, kind and community-oriented people has been felt in our community for many years. Through this scholarship opportunity, their legacy will continue to support and enrich the lives of those in our community.

Students who are graduates of Johnson County High School that plan to pursue a degree related to the field of Family and Consumer Sciences or Business, and who have shown dedication, passion and aptitude for the field are eligible to apply for this award.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college or technical school to pursue a degree related to the field of Family and Consumer Sciences or Business .

* Applicants should have a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities as well as participation in extracurricular school activities.

* Scholarship funds will be paid *in August (1/2 award amount) and January (1/2 award amount)* directly to the college where the student is enrolled. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the scholarship committee prior to these times an invoice for semester tuition and fees, student ID number official documentation of grades and credit hours earned from the previous semester and college payment information. *The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by a committee consisting of designees of the Brookshire family. The scholarship will be awarded in May 2021.

* This scholarship may be renewable. It will be the student's responsibility to submit a new application each year that he or she is enrolled in an undergraduate study program.
