- Give Ms. Davis ample notice that you need a transcript (at least one week).
- All applications are to be turned in to Ms. Davis unless otherwise stated.
- Watch the due date as applications will NOT be accepted in turned in after the due date.
- Read your instructions carefully as incomplete applications will NOT be considered.
- Be yourself, and be honest!
- Save all of your essays! You can modify most of them without starting from scratch.
- Don't put anything off until the last minute!!!
